

How do I check if I have a 32 or 64-bit Windows version?

Follow the steps below to find out if your computer is running a 32-bit or 64-bit Windows architecture:

1. Go to your PC and click the Windows **Start** button  |  in the lower-left corner of the screen.
2. In the search box, type **System Information**. If nothing comes up in the search results, type **msinfo32** instead.
3. Next, select **System Information** in the list of search results.
4. A new window will pop up on your screen. In the **System Type** section, you can see if it's an x86 (32-bit) or x64 (64-bit) based PC.
